DIRECTIONS

The meeting in San Francisco will be held in three locations:

The Wednesday evening event will be at the Faz Restaurant, 155 Steuart Street, San Francisco, CA 94105 (inside the Hotel Griffon).

The main sessions, starting Thursday morning, will be held at the UCSF Conference Center at the Mission Bay Campus, located at 1675 Owens Street (near 16th Street @ Third Streets), San Francisco, CA 94158.

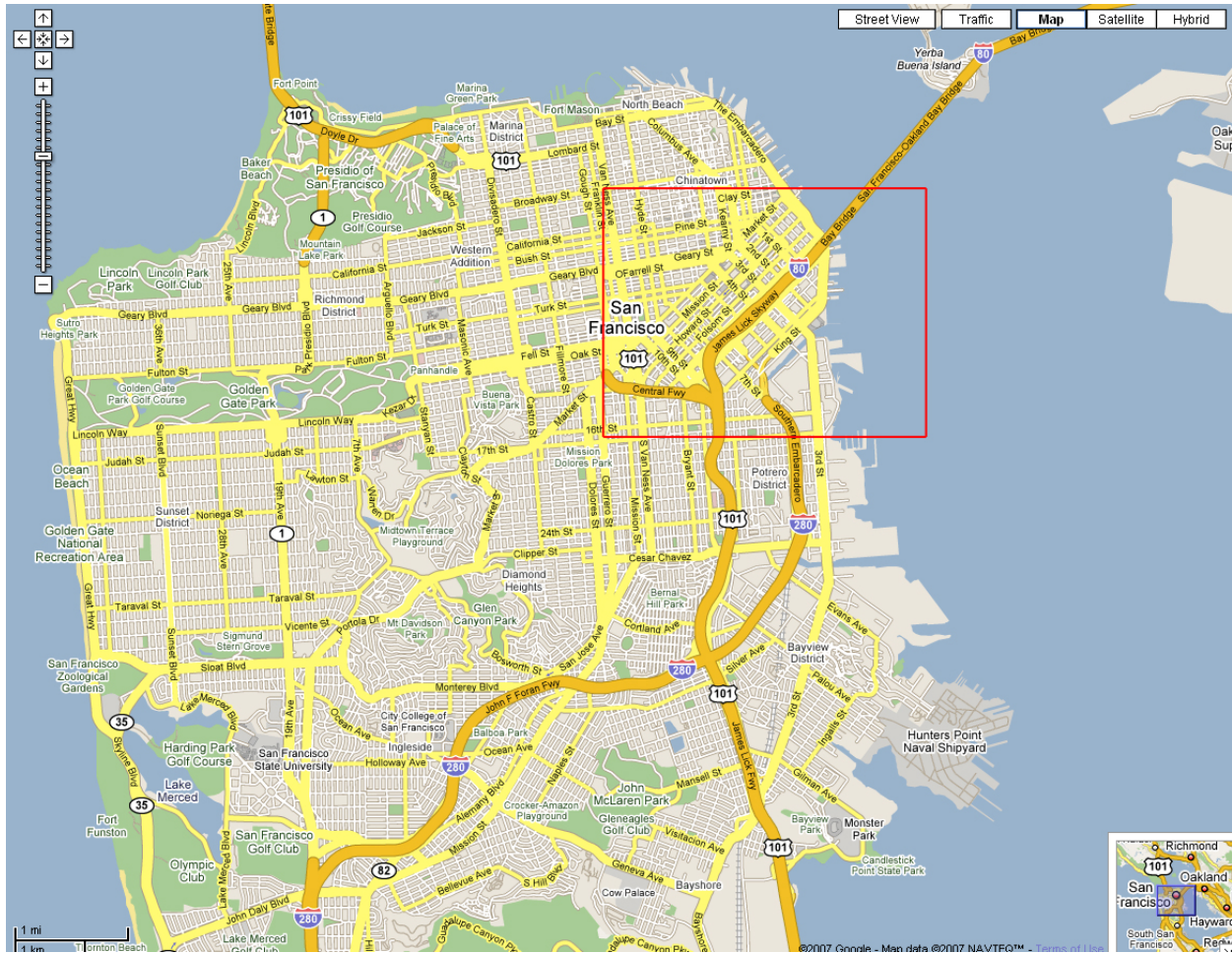
The Thursday evening event will be held at the Acme Chophouse, which is attached to the San Francisco baseball stadium (AT&T Park).

The maps over the next few pages provide general directions for locating each of these sites.

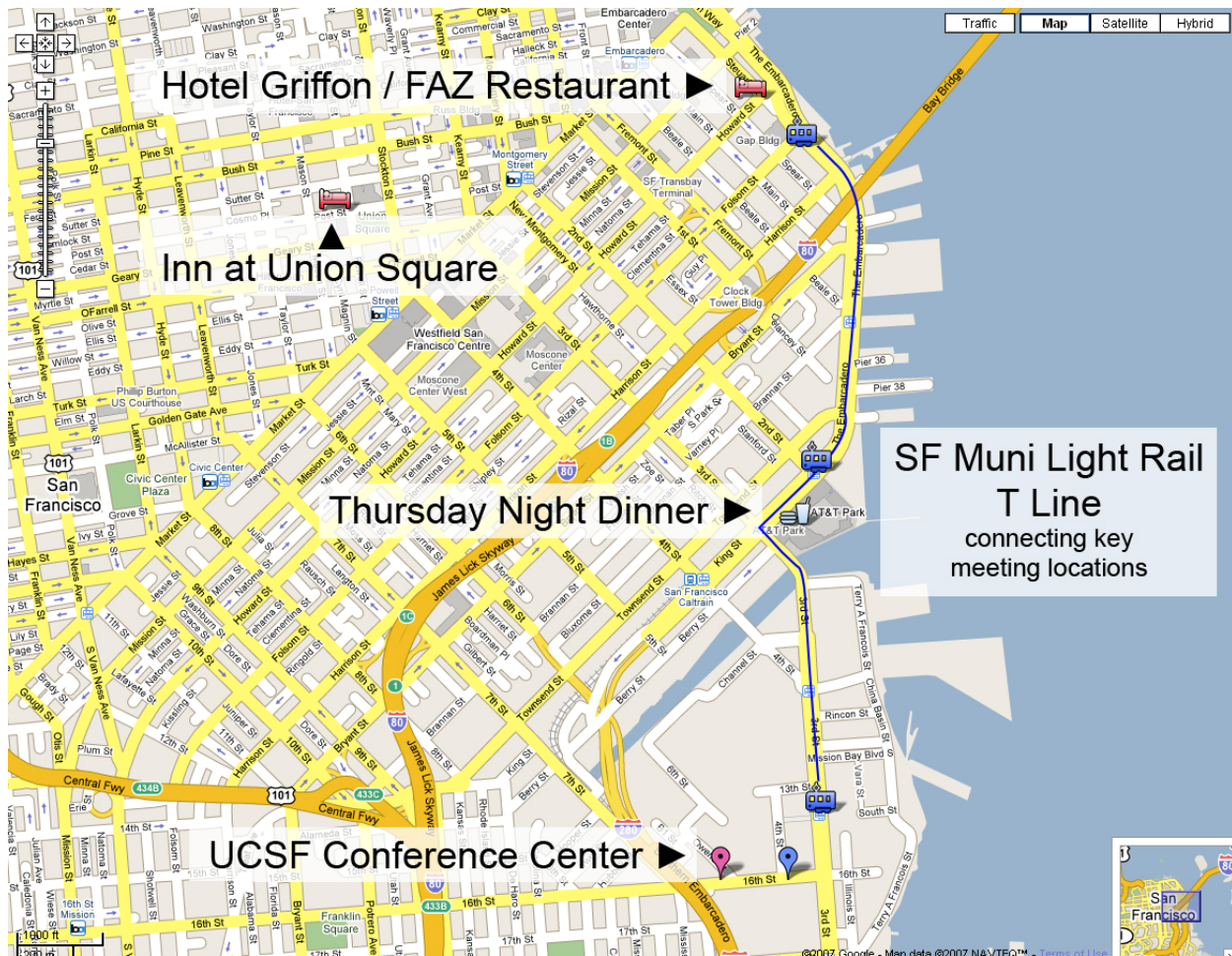

Overview of San Francisco: All of the meeting locations are within the area marked with the red box.



Close-up of San Francisco: The main hotel for the meeting is the Hotel Griffon. The overflow hotel is the Inn at Union Square.

The Wednesday night event will be held at the Faz Restaurant, which is inside the Hotel Griffon, located at 155 Stuart Street, San Francisco, CA 94105. For those staying at the Griffon, no travel is required Wednesday evening. For those at Union Square, the route to the Griffon is level (unlike the steep hills elsewhere in SF), so walking is an option, but only for those ready for a moderately long walk (maybe 15 or so blocks). A less onerous option would be to walk a few blocks down Post to Montgomery, then right on Montgomery to Market, and then pick up the T-line tram north (left on Market) to the Folsom stop. Or, one might just take a cab.

The main meeting starts at 8:00 am Thursday at the UCSF Conference Center, located at 1675 Owens Street (near 16th Street @ Third Streets), San Francisco, CA 94158. This is easily reachable from the Hotel Griffon by taking the SF Muni light-rail T line to the UCSF Conference Center. The T line runs along the Embarcadero and Third St and connects directly to the Mission Bay Campus at the Gene Friend stop (also known as the UCSF Mission Bay stop). The fare is \$1.50 each way.

Exit the train at the Gene Friend stop and take Gene Friend Way past 4th St. to get to the UCSF Conference Center.

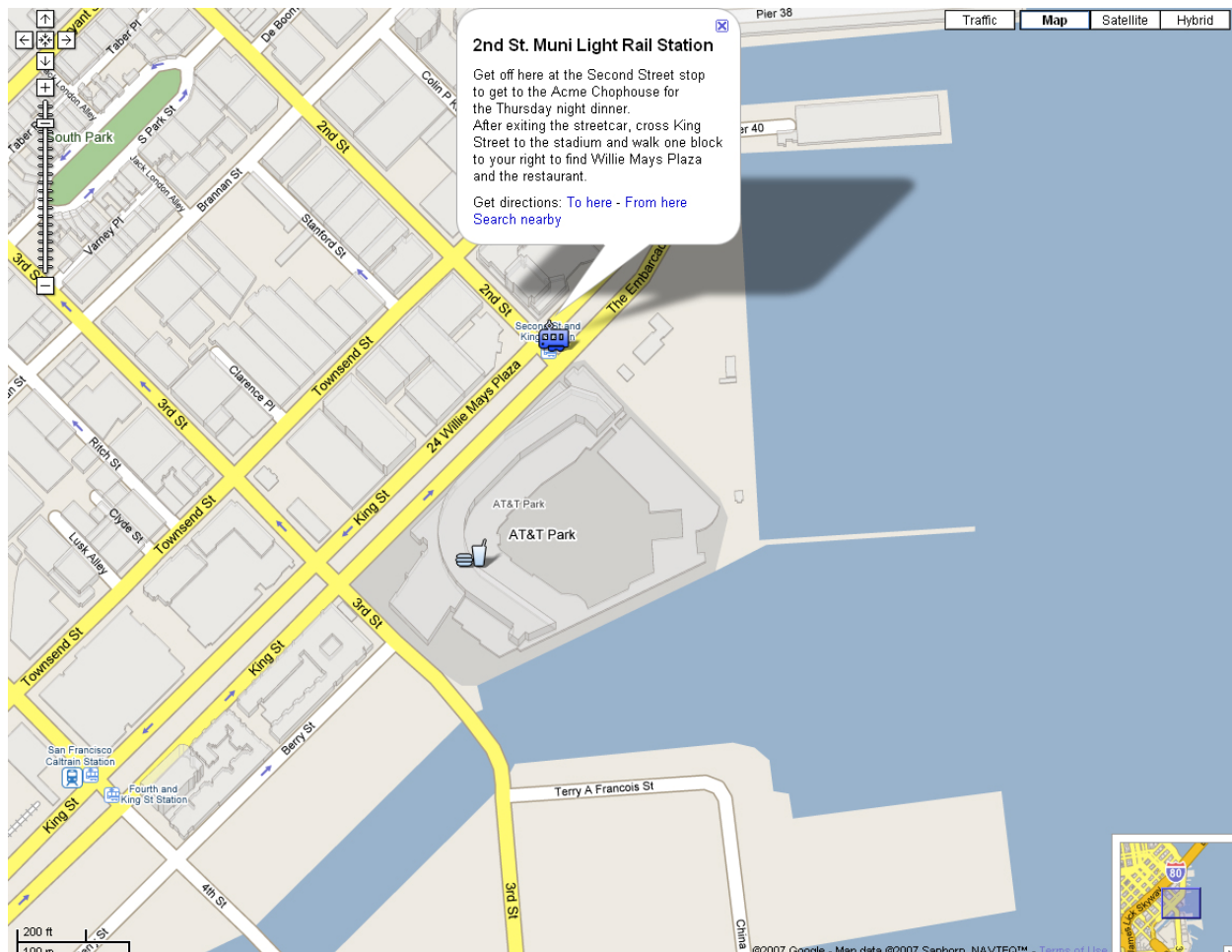

Close-up of AT&T Park Area: The Thursday evening event will be held at AT&T Park, which is located between the Hotel Griffon and the UCSF Conference Center.

There are several ways to get to AT&T Park from the UCSF Conference Center:

- Take the UCSF Teal Shuttle (which departs every 15 minutes - get off at China Basin building at 4th & King Streets and walk 1 block);

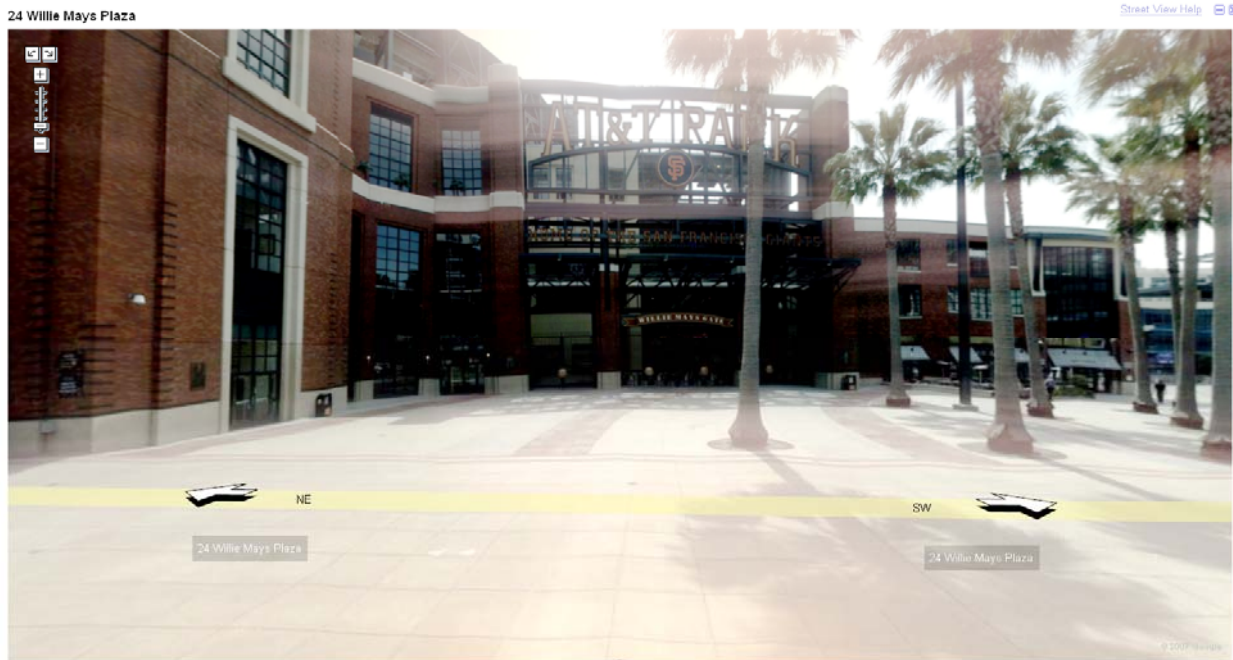
- Take the T-line street car (runs every 12 to 20 minutes; get off at 2nd & King); or

- Walk (takes 15-20 minutes) going north on Third Street.

The Thursday event includes an optional insider's tour of the stadium, followed by a reception / dinner at the Acme Chophouse Restaurant, which is attached to the stadium. To participate in the tour @ 6:00pm, meet inside the Acme Chophouse, 24 Willie Mays Plaza, San Francisco, CA 94107 (just south of the statue of Willie Mays). The Acme Chophouse is located on the ground level of the stadium on the west side. Tour departs from a door inside the restaurant. Dinner will be held after the tour, at approximately 7:00pm.



Close-up of AT&T Park Area: This will be your view, if you approach the stadium by crossing King on 2nd (as would happen if you take the T-line to the 2nd & King stop). After crossing the street, turn right in the direction marked SW above, and walk along the outside of the stadium.



Close-up of AT&T Park Area: Once you pass the length of the stadium, you will see a gate set back from the sidewalk (above). Note the awnings at ground level to the right of the gate. That is the Acme Chophouse.



T-line Tram Service: This is a map of the T-line Tram service. The stops that are closest to BRIITE locations are: **MONTGOMERY** (a few blocks from the Inn at Union Square), **FOLSOM** (one block from the Hotel Griffon and Faz Restaurant), **2nd AND KING** (next to AT&T Park, location of the Thursday evening event), and **GENE FRIEND** (closest to the UCSF Mission Bay Campus).
